Types of emergency:
Severe Weather (storm, wind, snow), power cut.

Personal Emergency Equipment Checklist:
Wind up torches, lamps, radios, spare batteries, phone chargers, tinned food, first aid kits.

On an emergency situation arising, the first action should always be to contact the emergency services by dialling 999.

Dialling from a landline will allow your call to be traced and will help pinpoint your location. Be prepared to give the following information. You may wish to complete the location details for your property now and place near to the phone.
