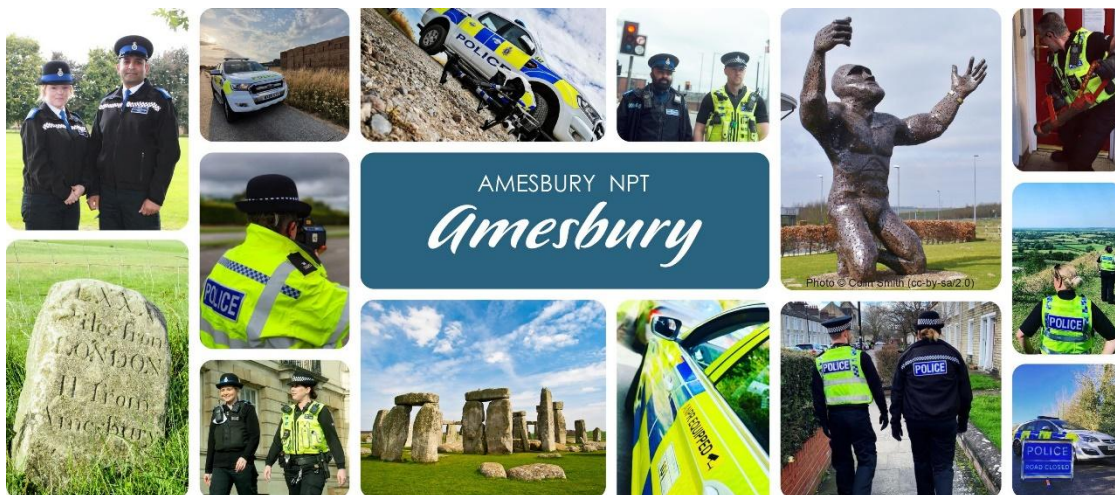

Pro-Active Work and Incidents Attended

Tidworth

- **Station Road, Tidworth-** Male was stopped by officers after being seen severing all over the road. Male blow 94 and was arrested for driving under the influence of alcohol. Enquiries are still ongoing. Patrol being conducted.
- **Safer Younger Persons** -Local neighbourhood officer has attended the multiagency safer young people's context meeting to discuss the children around the Tidworth and Ludgershall for following the report of ASB, theft around Tidworth and Ludgershall
- **Wellington Academy**– Unknown suspect has stolen mountain bike from school. The handlebar grips are worn quite smooth. Enquiries are still ongoing. Patrol being conducted.
- **Ashdown Terrace, Tidworth** – Officer was patrolling the area, sighted a male driving in excess of 30 MPH road and been issued a TOR (Traffic offence report) . Regular patrol being conducted in the area.
- **Lady Jane walk, Tidworth-** Unknown youth has been seen causing Anti-social behaviour around Lady jane walk, Tidworth. Regular patrol being conducted.
- **Wakes farm, Tidworth-** Unknown suspect(s) has forced entry into the detached garage causing minor damage to the door and padlock. Once inside, suspect(s) has stolen few items from the garage. Enquiries are still ongoing. Patrol being conducted in the area.
- **OP LAZURITE-** Ongoing regular reassurance patrol for those settled and transient member of the local Afghan community residing in locality as part of the op LAZURITE relocation program.
- **Tidworth:** Speed Enforcement recorded 47 vehicles speeding on 26 February 2026 in Tidworth on Park Road. Enforcement was conducted over two half-hour sessions, one just after the morning school run and one at midday. Though approximately the same number of drivers were recorded speeding during each session, significantly higher speeds were recorded during the midday session. This stretch of road has a clearly displayed speed limit of 30mph. The fastest vehicle was recorded accelerating to 53mph. On the day in question, it was overcast, with light rain at times. Roads were damp.

Depending on previous convictions and history: -

41 drivers will be offered a speed awareness course

5 drivers will receive a Fixed Penalty Notice and 3 points

1 driver will be subject to court recovery.

Proceedings will now be undertaken to ensure the most appropriate outcome for the offenders takes place.

Ludgershall

- **Perham Crescent** -Two unknown males have reversed a van on to the driveway and taken a broken washing machine which was left there for a genuine licenced scrap collector. Regular patrol being conducted.
- **Tesco, Ludgershall**-Known suspect has gone behind a counter and has stolen a litre of vodka. Enquiries are still ongoing. Patrol being conducted.
- **Roy's Close, Ludgershall** - A group of unknown youths has been seen smoking drugs, and they were detained for a Stop search at this location, however nothing found. Regular patrol being conducted.
- **CO-OP, Ludgershall** –Unknown suspects have entered the store and taken goods from the shelves. They have then left making no attempts to pay. Approx value of loss £200. Enquiries are still ongoing. Patrol being conducted.
- **Taylor Crescent**- In Taylor crescent local officer have dropped the Anti-social behaviour surveys for following the report of drug activities and ASB in the area.
- **Ludgershall**- Speed Enforcement recorded 6 vehicles speeding on 26 February 2026 in Ludgershall on the Tidworth Road.
This stretch of road has a clearly displayed speed limit of 30mph. The fastest vehicle was recorded travelling at 42mph. On the day in question, it was overcast with light, occasional rain and roads were damp.
Depending on previous convictions and history, all 6 drivers will be offered a speed awareness course.
Proceedings will now be undertaken to ensure the most appropriate outcome for the offenders takes place.

Everleigh, Collingbourne Ducis /Kingston

- **Pigleaze Diary, Everleigh-** Unknown suspects have entered garden of property. Padlock to garden shed has been removed by means unknown and access gained to shed. Items stolen approx. value is £385.
- **Salisbury plain Everleigh-** Multiple reports received about the quadbikes and dirt bike. Patrol being conducted on the plain.



- **Hare Coursing** -There has been increased of the hare coursing in the local area of Enford, Everleigh, Collingbourne Kingstone and Collingbourne Ducis, Netheravon. Neighbourhood team along with rural crime officer regularly patrolling the area.
- **Collingbourne Ducis:** Speed Enforcement recorded 7 vehicles speeding on 26 February 2026 in Collingbourne Ducis, near the junction with the Everleigh Road. This stretch of road has a clearly displayed speed limit of 30mph. However, the fastest vehicle was recorded travelling at 43mph. On the day in question, it was overcast with light, persistent rain and roads were damp.
Depending on previous convictions and history: -
6 drivers will be offered a speed awareness course
1 driver will receive a Fixed Penalty Notice and 3 points.
Proceedings will now be undertaken to ensure the most appropriate outcome for the offenders takes place.

Enford/East Chisenbury/ Netheravon

- **Netheravon-** Unknown suspect has sprayed graffiti onto the cob wall. CCTV enquiries have been completed. Patrol being committed.
- **Hare Coursing** -There has been increased of the hare coursing in the local area of Enford, Netheravon and East Chisenbury. Neighbourhood team along with rural crime officer regularly patrolling the area.

Community Engagement

- Local officer has attended the Wellington Lion school to deliver the school talk to year R and Year 1 children about People who keeps us safe.
- Local neighbourhood officers regularly doing the foot patrol of Wellington Academy. Engaged with the parents and children.
- Local officer has conducted the foot patrol in Tidworth and engaged with the local community. Ludgershall and gathered the intel.

Priority Patrols

- **Hare Coursing** -There has been increased of the hare coursing in the local area of Enford, Everleigh, COLLINGBOURNE DUCIS, COLLINGBOURNE KINGSTON f, Netheravon, Tidworth Ludgershall. Neighbourhood team along with rural crime officer regularly patrolling the area.



- Regular reassurance foot patrols of Ludgershall for following the reports of ASB and thefts.
- Regular reassurance foot patrols of Tidworth for following the report of ASB .
- Ongoing reassurance patrol of Chute for following the report of Burglary in the area.
- Ongoing reassurance patrol of Salisbury Plain for following the reports of ASB.
